

How to Talk to a Liberal



→ OPEN-MINDED Agree with me, even if doing so is in conflict with your own values (also see "Tolerance").

FAIR Taking something from Person A (who they don't think will vote for them) and giving it to Person B (who will vote for them) by raising taxes (also known as "redistribution of wealth").

GREED Any private economic success by anyone (opposite of "fair", see above); most often used in conjunction with the phrase "the rich".

INVEST Spending borrowed tax money without accountability for the results; often used with the words "for the children".

GUN CONTROL Confiscation of guns from law-abiding citizens or mandatory gun buy-backs (only government can be trusted with guns).

DIVERSITY Having lots of people from different backgrounds involved in supporting an issue who all think the same way (also see "Tolerance").

FEMINIST Someone who supports women's rights involving political, social, and economic equality to men, unless they are conservative or otherwise hold different views than they do.

COMPASSION Feeling good about yourself for raising taxes and generously spending other people's money on programs to help others, even if such programs don't do anything to effectively help others at all (also see "Tolerance").

TOLERANCE Unconditional acceptance of someone else's beliefs, even if they are not consistent with your own.
